Classroom Rules

1. Enter the room silently.

4. When an adult or student is addressing the class you are expected to listen.
5. Treat others how you would like to be treated.
6. Ask for permission to leave your seat or borrow supplies from the teacher/classmates.
7. Remain in your assigned seat until you are dismissed by the teacher.

Daily Expectations

1. Follow directions and class procedures, including completing assignments and homework.

4. Ask permission before leaving your assigned seat.
5. ALWAYS write the problem and show your work.

Consequences
